



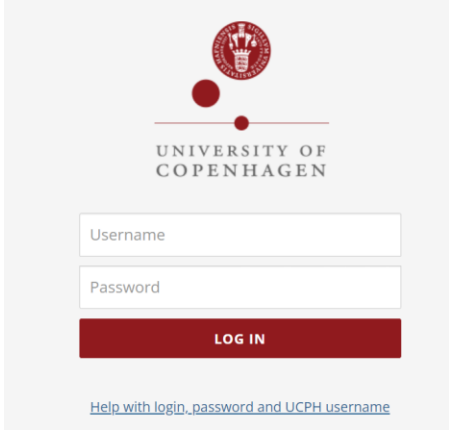
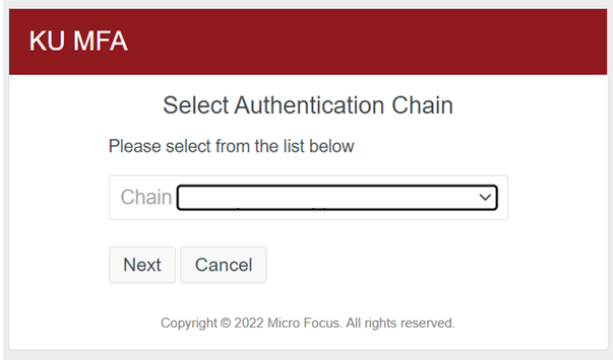
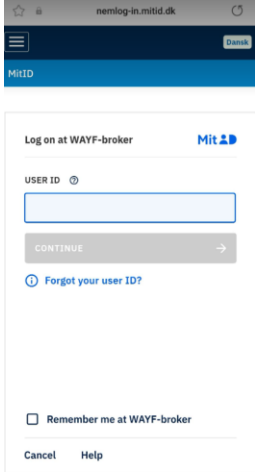
## Use MitID as multi-factor authentication

How to login to Copenhagen University's IT-systems – e.g., [KUnet](#) eller [KUmail](#) - using MitID as multi-factor authentication.
